

Information:

Suikerbosrand Nature Reserve covers a surface area of 19 000 ha including extensions and is named after the Transvaal Sugarbush (*Protea caffra*).

The dominant feature on the reserve is the Suikerbosrand mountain range. The altitude of which varies from 1 545 to 1 917 metres above sea level.

Day trails:

Bokmakiere: 10 km to 11.5 km
(please ignore 17km distance this was redesigned to 11,5km in the same direction of 17kms)
Cheetah: Approximately 4.5 km
Toktokkie accessible trail 1km

Tourist Route:

The tourist route is a 67 km tarred road which covers a large section of the reserve. Enjoy a picnic at Holhoek situated about half way on the route. Holhoek has braai facilities, running water and ablution facilities.

Visitor Services:

For organized learner groups. There is a wide variety of programmes available (based on OBE) which will be presented to the group by an official. Bookings should be done 3 months in advance.

Overnight hiking trails:

Minimum 2, maximum 10 persons, self-guided, 6 huts to choose from, you plan your own route. Trail can be from 1 to 6 nights. You cannot stay at the same hut for more than one night. Facilities include: 10 mattresses, enviro loo, braai, kettle, bucket, 2 pots and an axe. **ALL Six huts are available, Blesbok, Springbok, Duiker, Steenbok, Hartebeest & Eland**
